- 5 days a week: \$250/month

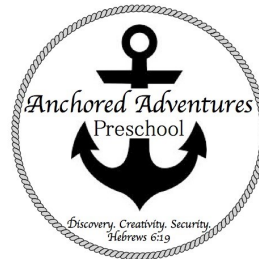
Classes (8:30am-12:00pm):
