Carry a Big Stick: The Uncommon Heroism of Theodore Roosevelt
 by George Grant
 Seldom has America had leaders that are larger than life. As our 26th President, his innovations grew out of his conservative Christian principles. He believed our nation should be ruled by the 10 Commandments. To Roosevelt, Christianity was not just the plan of salvation, but an ethical system. It was truth about all things for all men for all times. He regarded socialism and communism with equal disdain. As American troops headed into battle in World War I, he was asked to write a message in the pocket New Testament that each soldier would be given. He wrote Micah 6:8, "He has shown you, O man, what is good; And what does the Lord require of you But to do justly, To love mercy, And to walk humbly with your God?". Teddy Roosevelt is included in the sculpted memorial at Mt. Rushmore as one of America's greatest statesmen.
