Through My Eyes by Tim Tebow and Nathan Whitaker

No matter one's football preferences, everyone should be inspired by Tebow's story of faith and how he defied convention to become one of the GOAT quarterbacks of college football.

Tim writes how his Christian faith, family values, and his relentless drive to succeed have molded him into the man he is today. He states that God is concerned that we are trusting and seeking Him, that we are aligning our lives with His will.

Many stories about Tim have been filtered through opinions of others. Setting the record straight, Tebow tells of his long and difficult path to becoming a QB, a path blocked by coaches telling him he'd never make it. The coaches must have had egg on their face when Tebow became the first sophomore to win the Heisman trophy. Even if you're not a fan of football, you'll be inspired by Tebow's words of faith as he tells his life's story through his eyes.
