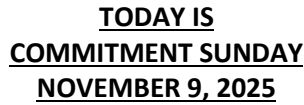

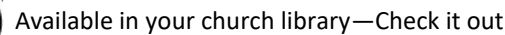
The Handwriting on the Wall; Secrets from the prophetic writings of Daniel

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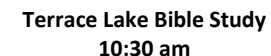
